

While children think in terms of fun, fresh air and wonder while playing outside, teachers think in terms of learning:

- Speech and language areas spontaneous language dramatically increases when children play outside
- Physical areas leaping, running, jumping, chasing, and climbing all develop large motor skills
- Occupational areas small fingers work hard and there are all kinds of sensory experiences waiting in God's world
- Social areas talking to friends, sharing, turntaking, negotiating and group exploring grow strong social connections
- Emotional areas risk-taking, the power of 'being free' and feeling connected to a larger world encourage positive emotional development
- Cognitive areas problem-solving skills ("what will happen if..."), observing and experiencing the way the world works develop a child's mind
