Summer Activities for Outdoor Fun (While Improving Skill Levels)

Tactile Experiences:

1) Fill a small inflatable swimming pool with water, sponges, and ice cubes. Encourage your child to experiment with texture, temperature, and splashing.

2) Bury your child's body parts in sand, leaves, or grass clippings, then hose her off.

3) Have your child walk barefoot in the grass or lie down and roll across the yard. Encourage him to join in races where children crawl across the grass as fast as possible and knock down a tower of bottles at

the finish line.

Large & Fine Motor Development:

1) Have your child decorate an outdoor area with tiny stones or collect pretty rocks and sort them in an egg carton.

2) Allow your child and a friend to have an outdoor water fight, chasing each other and squeezing the handles on spray bottles.

3) Give your child sidewalk chalk to draw pictures and words.

4) Encourage lots of play on the equipment at the park.
