The last section will give you an opportunity to upload all supporting documents so be sure to have these in a place where you can access them efficiently.

- Any reports or documents relating to support services that have been accessed by the student
- Canadian birth certificate or other government documentation that allow your student to be in Canada (example: PR card (both sides), Canadian citizenship document (both sides), work or study permit, refugee documents, etc...)
- Custody documents (if applicable)

PLEASE NOTE: Your application will be considered incomplete until ALL required information and documents are provided, and your \$250 application fee is paid. Other applications will be processed ahead of yours if all necessary documentation is not provided upon submission of the application.
